We're looking forward to welcoming you to the 23rd National Police Memorial Day, which is taking place in less than two weeks time, at the Waterfront Hall, Belfast.

Ahead of this special day for the police family, please read on for some important updates.

Security

The following advice will help ensure you remain safe while in Belfast.

It is recommended that all officers change on site and do not travel in full or half uniform.

Away from the venue

- Avoid wearing 'police' uniform, branded clothing, or other items which would identify you as police (changing facilities will be available at the venue).
- Please consider bringing uniform in a cover that cannot easily be seen within hotel rooms.
- Please do not have any police related items on display in hotel rooms.
- Be mindful of persons overhearing conversations, particularly on 'police' related topics, and in conversation try to avoid revealing your occupation, or the reason for your visit.
- If you intend to travel elsewhere (away from the venue and Belfast City Centre) please have a chat with one of the PSNI officers for advice.

Transport

- Only use legally licensed taxis fitted with a roof sign & license plate. The majority of taxis within Northern Ireland have apps for booking.

Tickets

A reminder that entry is by ticket only and photographic ID is required.

If you have registered tickets that you now do not require, please could you cancel them via Eventbrite to release tickets for others.
